This week marks 30 years since women were first ordained in Guildford. On Sunday 24 April 1994, Guildford Cathedral witnessed one of the first groups of women being ordained as priests following the acceptance of women into this sacred role. The service was a momentous occasion, and the order of service for this historic event is preserved in the Capitular records of Guildford Cathedral. Presiding at this service was Bishop Michael Adie, whose funeral service was held at the cathedral last month. He had been instrumental in introducing and proposing the measure to allow women to become ordained at General Synod.
