Two New Community Projects in Cranleigh - Repair Cafe and Make Do & Mend. Both are run entirely by volunteers with the aim to repair broken items for people in the community so that they do not need to go into landfill. The repairs are free unless parts are required, and refreshments are available while you wait for your item to be repaired.

The Repair Cafe is held one Saturday morning a month at Cranleigh Baptist Church. Next dates are Sat 3 August and Sat 7 September from 10am to 1pm. We repair all sorts of items. We take walk ins on the day but it is advisable to book a slot and the email address is cranleighrepaircafe@gmail.com.

The Make Do & Mend is held one Saturday morning a month at Cranleigh Library. We meet from 10am to 1pm and the next dates are Sat 20 July and Sat 17 August. We repair all sorts of textile items, from household textiles such as cushion covers and blankets, to clothing. The only thing we cannot repair are zips but we will tackle most other things.
